



Year 4s Summer Term 2022 Overview

Art	Computing & Online Safety	Design Technology
Sycamore class will be looking at the use of shape within art and how they can be used when printing on fabric, We will also be exploring mosaics and tessellation.	In Summer 1 the children will be exploring how to edit photos. By Summer 2 the children will have further developed their programming knowledge, looking at repetition in games.	This term our topic in design technology is food. We will be exploring variety of healthy ingredients to make a savoury dish.
English	French	Geography
In English we will be developing our writing skills, exploring a range of grammatical features. Sycamore class will be writing a persuasive text as well as an alternative narrative based on our whole class reading text.	We will be learning how to tell the time in French as well as looking at holidays and hobbies.	This terms topic is rivers. We will be exploring the features of a river and comparing the River Trent to rivers around the world.
History	Maths	Music
In History, we will be focussing on the Queen Victoria. The children will explore Victorian life in houses of Gotham as well as improvements in sanitation. There will be opportunities to compare school life in the Victorian era compared to now.	This term, our focus will be on decimals, money and time.	Sycamore class will be developing their appraising skills before moving onto applying their knowledge and understanding to a range of different songs. We will be describing the different purposes of music in history/ other cultures.
PE	PSHE/RHSE	RE
This term in PE, the children will be developing their batting technique in cricket. We will also be continuing our swimming block until 20 th June.	In Autumn 1 the focus will be online safety and the wider world, looking at what it means to be part of a community. In Autumn 2 the children will be looking at Road Safety.	Over the summer term we will be looking at spiritual expression in a variety of religions. We will be exploring how Hindu families practise their faith and the deeper meanings of Hindu festivals.
Science	Whole Class Reading	
We will be continuing our topic on electricity before looking at the human body. We will be exploring the process of digestion as well as the roles of teeth.	We will be reading Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone by J.K. Rowling	
Maths and English are taught daily. Computing, French, music, PE, science and PSHE/RHSE are taught weekly. The other subjects are taught in small blocks unless they are covered by a PPA teacher.
